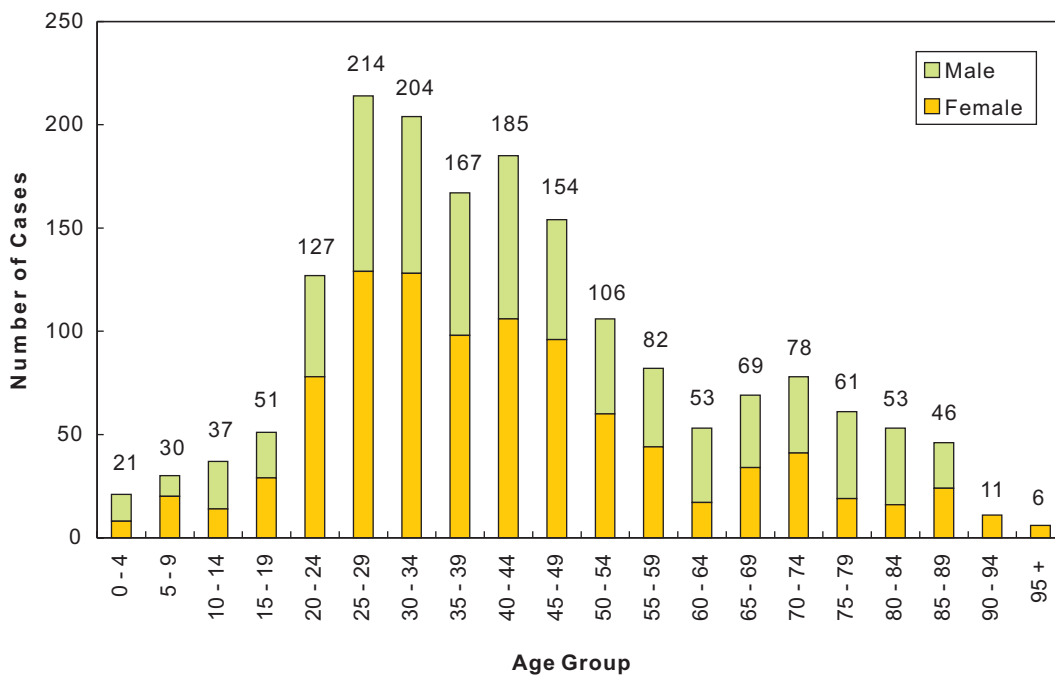
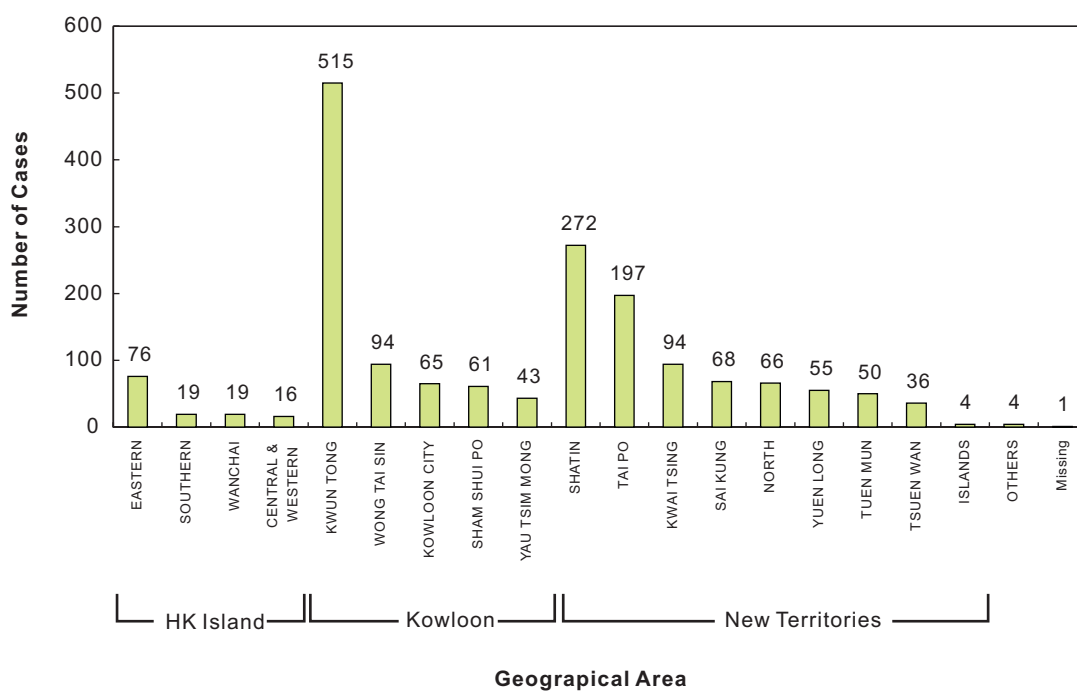


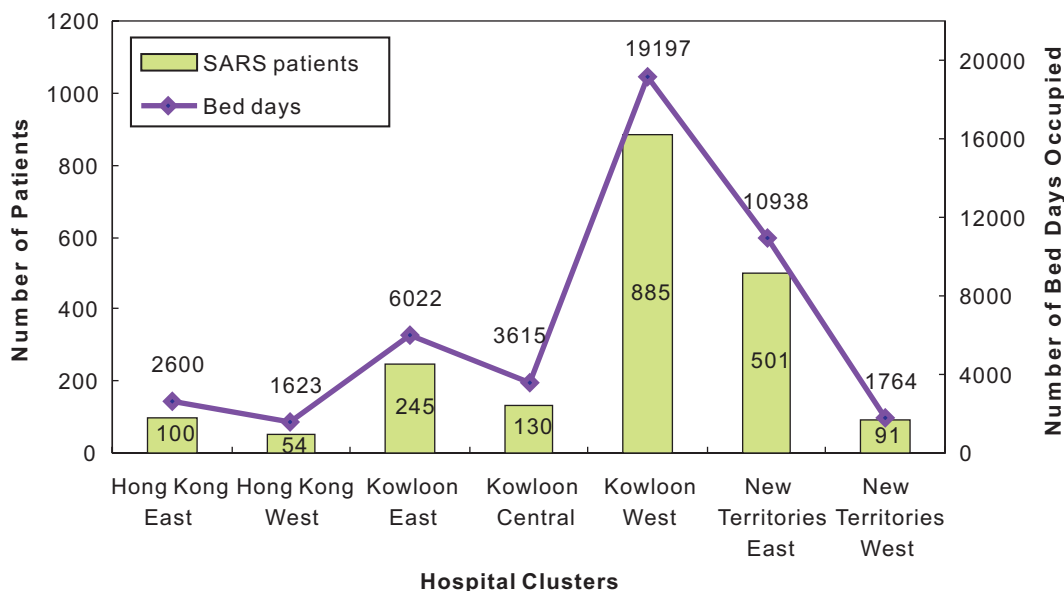
### (i) Number of SARS cases by age and sex



### (ii) Number of SARS cases by geographical areas

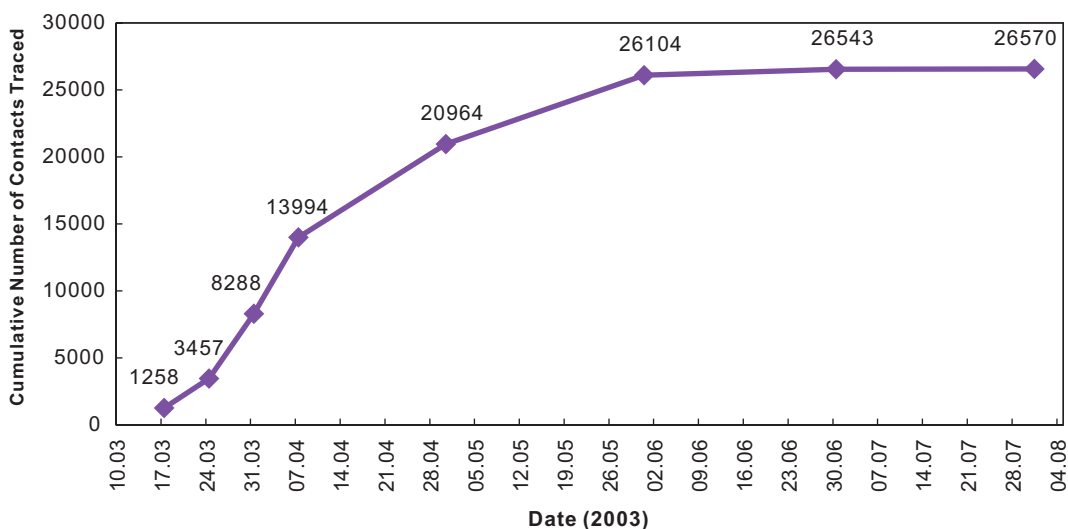


(iii) Number of SARS patients treated and the corresponding hospital bed days by hospital clusters, as at 3 August 2003
